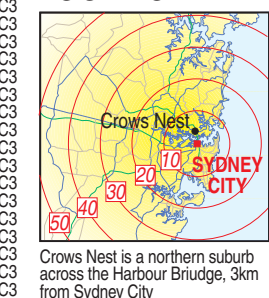

ABOUT CROWS NEST

Crows Nest is a suburb approximately five kilometres north of Sydney city, on the lower North Shore. Administered by the councils of North Sydney, Willoughby and Lane Cove.

It was founded in 1819 when Edward Wollstonecraft received a 524 acre land grant over both the modern-day suburb and Wollstonecraft. He named it Crows Nest Farm, and built a home, 'Crows Nest House', on what later became site of the North Sydney Demonstration School. According to his associate Alexander Berry, after whom the local creek was named, Wollstonecraft chose the name for "its elevated and commanding position". Berry died at Crows Nest House on 30 November, 1873.

Today Crows Nest is a significant commercial district noted for its varied shops and restaurants. At the junction of five main roads on the highest point of elevation in Crows Nest, about 1km north by northwest of the original site of Crows Nest House. The gates of Crows Nest House still stand at the Pacific Highway entrance to North Sydney Demonstration School.
